### **A Message from the Pastor**

Jesus' public ministry begins after the arrest of John the Baptist. Mark wants his readers to understand the important connection between the end of the ministry of John the Baptist and the beginning of Jesus' own ministry.

As we learn at the beginning of today's Gospel reading, Jesus preaches the Kingdom of God in continuity with the preaching of John the Baptist. Like John the Baptist, Jesus' pronouncement of the kingdom is a call to repentance. Yet Jesus' preaching is greater than John's. Jesus begins the time of fulfillment; the Kingdom of God is already here. This will be demonstrated again and again, both in Jesus' words and in the actions that follow. Jesus' healing and forgiveness of sins are signs of the Kingdom of God that he announces in his teaching.

Jesus is said to have first called four fishermen—Simon, Andrew, James, and John. Simon and Andrew are brothers. Jesus promises that he will make them "fishers of men." James and John are also brothers. Mark's Gospel is told with a great sense of urgency and immediacy. Jesus is a person of action, and events occur in rapid succession. We see this in today's Gospel. Time is of the essence; the fishermen immediately put aside their livelihood to become Jesus' disciples. The Kingdom of God is here and now. The time of fulfillment is at hand. How might our lives be different if we more fully shared this sense of the immediacy of God's kingdom?

### **Un mensaje del Pastor**

*El ministerio público de Jesús comienza después del arresto de Juan el Bautista. Marcos quiere que sus lectores entiendan la importante conexión entre el fin del ministerio de Juan el Bautista y el comienzo del propio ministerio de Jesús.*

*Al aprender al comienzo de la lectura evangélica de hoy, Jesús predica el Reino de Dios en continuidad con la predicación de Juan el Bautista. Al igual que Juan el Bautista, el pronunciamiento del reino de Jesús es un llamado al arrepentimiento. Sin embargo, la predicación de Jesús es mayor que la de Juan. Jesús comienza el tiempo de la realización; el Reino de Dios ya está aquí. Esto se demostrará una y otra vez, tanto en las palabras de Jesús como en las acciones que siguen. La sanación y el perdón de Jesús de los pecados son signos del Reino de Dios que anuncia en su enseñanza. Se dice que Jesús primero llamó a cuatro pescadores: Simón, Andrés, Santiago y Juan. Simon y Andrew son hermanos. Jesús promete que los hará "pescadores de hombres". James y John también son hermanos. El Evangelio de Marcos se cuenta con un gran sentido de urgencia e inmediatez. Jesús es una persona de acción, y los acontecimientos ocurren en rápida sucesión. Vemos esto en el Evangelio de hoy. El tiempo es esencial; los pescadores inmediatamente dejaron a un lado su sustento para convertirse en discípulos de Jesús. El Reino de Dios está aquí y ahora. El tiempo de cumplimiento está cerca. ¿Cómo podría nuestra vida ser diferente si compartiéramos más plenamente este sentido de la inmediatez del reino de Dios?*
